Fr. Michael says.....

I'd like to share a message from an aspiring film director with you all:

Hello! My name is Cecilia Anthony. 6 years ago the Lord led me to the incredible story of the Carmelite Martyrs of Compiegne. They were 16 nuns during the French Revolution who, in response to the horrific persecution and violence of the Revolution, began praying a daily act of consecration as a community, offering themselves in totality to the Lord, including martyrdom if the Lord willed it. After two years of praying this daily, they were arrested on falsified charges and later sentenced to execution because of their "attachment to their religion". They went to their executions literally singing praises to God, which inspired an unprecedented silence from the surrounding crowds, and just ten days later Robespierre fell, and the French Revolution came to an end.

This summer I will be filming a short Proof-of-Concept film about their story, that I will use to hopefully attract potential investors and producers to help make the full-length film a reality. I am currently a youth minister, so I have no ability to have a budget for this film at this time. I am relying on the Lord and the generosity of people who are interested in becoming involved in making it happen. The Chief Cinematographer of a small Catholic production company in Maryland is coming out to film it the week of July 20th (specifically July 22-25).

The Lord has been opening multiple doors to make this short film possible, but what I really need the most at the moment are people who can help out during the days of filming. There are multiple different roles and responsibilities that I am looking for assistance with. I need extras, I need actors, mostly women between the ages of 25-85 but a few men and a child as well (there is an audition process for the acting roles), and I need practical help as well during the days of filming. The Priesthood and the Eucharist

“These two Sacraments were born together,” wrote St. John Paul II of the priesthood and the Eucharist, “and their destiny is indissolubly linked until the end of the world.”

The Eucharist is such a beautiful example of how God, conscious of our limitations, bends to meet us. He once came to us cloaked in the flesh, that we might recognize Him. Now He comes as the very means by which we nourish ourselves: food and drink, the most familiar and comforting thing in the world to us. How easy He makes it to fulfill his command that we become one with Him. How generous He is to make such a sacred thing also accessible.

We can say the same of the priesthood, and of the men He calls to its number. How generous of Him to make such an accessible thing — our sons, our brothers, our uncles, our cousins — sacred. How generous of Him to allow these human creations — who share in our own faults — to be the means through which He comes to us in the Eucharist.

Without the Eucharist, we would have no eternal life. Without priests, we would have no Eucharist. On this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let’s give thanks for our priests, and redouble our prayers that God will send us good and holy ones — manna from Heaven in our wandering exile.

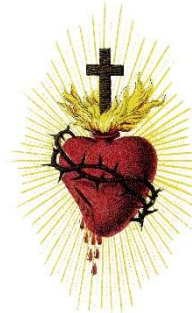
