

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

FR. MICHAEL SAYS.....

This Wednesday is the feast of St. Thomas Aquinas, one of the great thinkers, writers, and saints of our Church.

St. Thomas' family sent him to study at a Benedictine monastery when he was young, hoping that he would enter the order and eventually become the abbot. The Benedictines were a respected community with a long history.

Instead, Thomas joined the Dominicans, a fairly new community dedicated to preaching. At one point, his family kept him prisoner for over a year to try to dissuade him. They did not succeed. He spent years studying theology in Paris and Cologne before beginning to teach and write.

His most famous work, the *Summa Theologiae*, was actually never finished. He stopped working on it after celebrating Mass on December 6, 1273. When asked why he stopped writing, he replied, "I cannot go on.... All that I have written seems to me like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me." He died March 7, 1274.

St. Thomas's feast day always falls during National Catholic Schools Week. As the patron of students, let's ask him to pray for our local Catholic schools and everyone associated with them.

One regular parish event that you may not be aware of is **Bosco Boys** - a weekly event for young men led by Deacon Peter.

Every Monday at 6:30pm, young men in high school and college gather in Blessed Sacrament for a holy hour of Eucharistic Adoration. They pray the rosary together during this time.

Afterwards, they eat a meal in lower Sargus Hall (a meal usually prepared by Deacon Peter himself!) and then spend time playing games or sports outside, weather permitting.

All of this is about growing in holiness, hearing God's voice, and supporting each other.

I would encourage any men of our parishes who are in high school or college to give it a try but also would ask everyone to pray for the young people of our

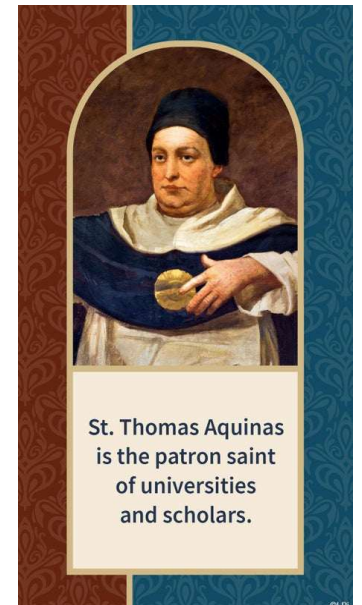
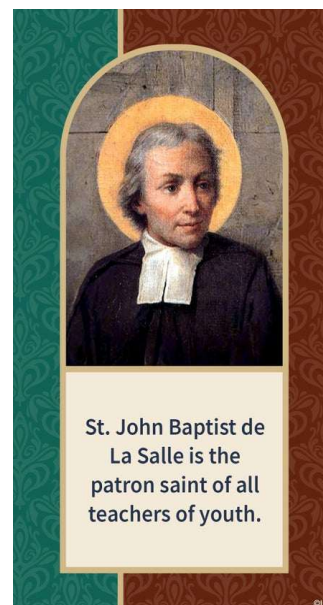
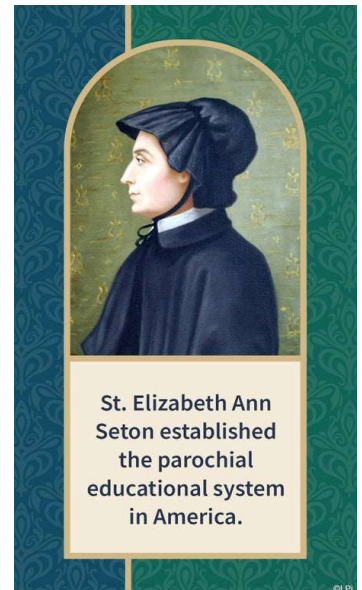
