Elizabeth's husband Louis died in the Crusades after 6 years of marriage. She suffered persecution from his family after his death but was restored to the palace and her position when her son became king.

She joined the Secular Franciscan Order towards the end of her short life and spent her time caring for the poor in a hospital which she had founded.
